

FEES

Because the Church of England is a state church the fees for a wedding are set nationally, by Parliament.

There are also some optional fees as below, and we will discuss these with you.

In order to secure the date of your wedding, we require a £50 deposit, which is returnable up to six months before the wedding. Cheques should be made payable to 'Highnam Benefice Account' and sent to the Benefice Administrator C/O The Rectory, 25 Maidenhall, Highnam, GL2 8DJ.
